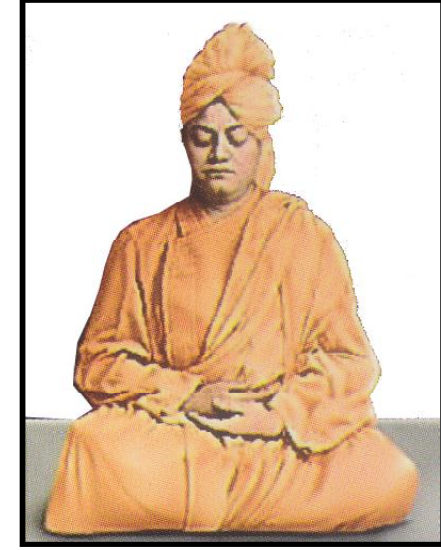

A Short history of the life of the Mother Sarada Devi

Sarada Mani Devi, called "**Sarada**" for short and later known and revered in India and abroad as Holy Mother, was born on December 22, 1853, in the little village Jayarambadi in the district of Bankura, situated about sixty miles to the west of Calcutta.

Her parents, Ramachandra Mukhopadhyaya and Shyamasundari, were orthodox brahmins devoted to their traditional religious and social customs.

At the age of five Sarada was married to Shri Ramakrishna. The strange marriage of Gadadhar of twenty three years of age with Sarada of five was part of a divine dispensation, and took place in a way that can only be described as providential.

Her whole life was occupied with acts of Service for the Master and his devotees and with the practice of devotional disciplines. It was an ideal way of living in which work and worship went hand in hand and led to a harmonious development of personality. She dedicated her entire life to uplift the standard of the down trodden and the poor people.

GENERAL DISCIPLINE

- ★ Perfect silence should prevail during congregational prayer every morning. Students should assemble in their respective places in order at 9.45 a.m.

- ★ No meeting of any kind shall be held in the College without the prior written permission of the Principal.

- ★ No student shall take part in political agitation directed against the authority of the Government or engage prominently in any public movement.

- ★ No notice of any kind shall be circulated among students or posted on the Notice Board without the previous written sanction of the Principal.

- ★ Private collection of funds must not be made without the prior approval of the authorities.

- ★ Genuine grievance may be brought to the notice of the authorities or may be put in the grievance boxes.

Note : Under the Government's Educational Rules the Principal has full power to inflict the following punishment. Fine, Loss of Attendance, Loss of Term Certificates, Suspension and Expulsion.

ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE OF ABSENCE

- ★ Punctual and regular attendance for class and games is insisted upon.

- ★ **Bio-Metric system**

'Bio-Metric system for students' attendance is followed. The presence and leave of the students are informed to their parents through SMS immediately after pressing their finger prints.

- ★ Ordinarily, a week consists of six working days.
- ★ The working day is divided into two sessions. The forenoon session is divided into three periods, the afternoon into 2 periods. Prayer begins at **9.45 a.m.**

Forenoon session starts at 10.00 a.m.

Lunch break between 1.00 p.m. to 1.45 p.m.

College will be over at 3.45 p.m.

Enrichment classes and Remedial Coaching Classes will be conducted by teachers from 3.45 to 4.45 p.m.

- ★ Students who appear for competitive examinations are trained by Competitive Exams Training Cell of our college.
- ★ Every day the morning session will commence with a prayer meeting presided over by the Principal.
- ★ Attendance will be taken at beginning of the morning and evening.
- ★ No student will be allowed to absent herself from the College without leave letter, for which she must apply in advance stating explicit reasons for her absence.
- ★ The leave letter applied should be duly signed by the class teacher and counter signed by the parent/ guardian / hostel warden. The leave letter should be submitted to the class teacher.

- ★ In case where absence is due to unforeseen causes the application for leave should be submitted as soon as possible and not later than the first day of return to the College.
- ★ Continued irregularity will be seriously dealt with .
- ★ A student who is continuously absent herself for 6 days without sufficient reason will have her name struck off the rolls.
- ★ Permission will not be granted normally during working hours to meet the parents, guardian, relatives or friends.
- ★ Students must not absent themselves from Internal tests and pre-semester examinations.
- ★ Minimum attendance requirement is 75%.
- ★ Recommendation for exemption in case of shortage of attendance cannot be claimed as a matter of right.

LIBRARY

- ★ The Library is open to all the members of the College.
- ★ The Library will be kept open from **9.30 a.m. to 4.30 p.m.** on all working days.
- ★ The Library will be closed on Sundays and other public holidays.
- ★ No student can ordinarily take out more than two books at a time.
- ★ Members of the staff may take 5 books at a time besides the table copies. They should return the books at the end of each month.
- ★ Application for books shall be made in the prescribed form (can be had from the library) between 1.00 p.m. and 2.00 p.m. Books will be issued on week days between **3.45 p.m. 4.30 p.m.**

- ★ A student is not entitled to keep books for more than a week from the date of issue and they may be renewed consecutively twice if there are no requests for them. A fine of 3 Rupees per day and 25 Rupees per week per book (including holidays) will be levied if the books are retained beyond the period allowed. The student will not be permitted to use the library till the fine is paid and the books are returned with fine on the working day immediately following. If a book is overdue by one week the Librarian will report the matter to the Principal.
- ★ No one is allowed to sublend to others the books taken out by her.
- ★ Books have to be treated and handled with great care. Fines will be levied for mishandling of books and cards.
- ★ Students must, on receiving books, examine them and report to the Librarian if any damage found therein. Otherwise they will be responsible for any damage that may be afterwards detected.
- ★ In the event of loss or damage to a book the person responsible shall either pay its cost or supply the Library with a new copy within a fortnight.
- ★ Books, periodicals, etc. must not be underlined, written upon, tampered with or defaced in any manner.
- ★ The Librarian, for the purpose of cataloguing or for any other purpose may recall a book at any time even if the normal period of lien has not expired.
